

Dear Brothers and Sisters, Friends, and Valued Partners,

I am writing to you today with a sincere and humble heart about a challenge facing our family and our ability to remain in ministry with Alliance Missions in El Salvador.

As many of you know, our mission requires us to raise a significant portion of our own compensation. This financial partnership is what allows us to dedicate our lives fully to the work God has called us to.

Lately, we have been facing a significant shortfall in our personal support. As of today, we only have approximately **\$400 in recurring monthly commitments**. While God has been faithful through unexpected one-time gifts, we currently need to establish a more consistent foundation to ensure our long-term stability.

Our Immediate Goal: Three Months of Stability

To meet the organization's standard and secure our family's future here, we have two urgent needs:

1. **Catch-Up Support:** We need to raise **\$6,000 within the next month**. This will bring our personal support three months ahead, providing us with a critical buffer.
2. **Consistent Monthly Partners:** We need to find an additional **\$1,600 in recurring monthly support** to complete our **\$2,000 monthly goal**.

This essential monthly need can be met through committed partners like you! For example, this could look like:

- **16** partners committing to **\$100** per month
- **32** partners committing to **\$50** per month
- **64** partners committing to **\$25** per month
